•Lactobacillus LB

## Pharmacological properties

Antidiarrheal of microbial origin, with:

- direct bacterteriostatic action and stimulation of the growth of the defensive acidogenic intestinal flora,
- non-specific immunostimulation of the mucosa (increased synthesis of IgA).
- inhibition of adherence of invasive or toxinogenic enteropathogenic organisms (Escherichia coil, Camplobacter jejuni) to epithelial cells

### **Indications**

Symptomatic treatment of diarrhea.
