#### WHAT EASIFLAM MOUTHWASH IS USED FOR

For the temporary relief of painful conditions of the oral cavity including: tonsilities, sore throat, radiation mucositis, aphthous ulcers, post-orosurgical and periodontal procedures.

#### HOW EASIFLAM MOUTHWASH WORKS

WORKS
Easiflam Mouthwash contains Benzydamine
Hydrochloride, one of a group of medicines
called non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs
(NSAIDs). Benzydamine Hydrochloride has
anti-inflammatory and analgesic effect to stop
pain and inflammation. It does this by
stabilizing the cellular membrane and
stopping the formation of prostaglandin.

HOW TO USE EASIFLAM MOUTHWASH

MOUTHWASH

\_HOW MUCH TO USE
Follow all directions given to you by your doctor, dentist or pharmacist carefully. They may differ from the information contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor, dentist or pharmacist for help.

Do not swallow the mouthwash. Easiflam Mouthwash is for use in the throat or mouth. It should be rinsed around the mouth or used as a gargle according to the following instructions:

Adult and Elderly When used as a gargle, the dose is 15ml (approximately one tablespoon) which should be gargled for at least 30 seconds every  $1^{1/2}$  to 3 hours, as needed.

When used as a rinse for oral lesions, the dose is 15ml (approximately 1 tablespoon) which should be held in the mouth and swirled around for at least 30 seconds, repeat every  $1^{1/2}$  to 3 hours.

#### Children

Easiflam mouthwash is not recommended in

children under 6 years of age
5-15ml as a gargle if able to do so, or as an oral rinse.

With Impaired Renal Function
Since absorbed benzydamine and its
metabolites are excreted in the urine, the
possibility of systemic effects should be
considered in patients with severe renal impairment.

#### With Impaired Liver Function

Since absorbed benzydamine is highly metabolized in the liver, the possibility of systemic effects should be considered in vere liver impairment

- <u>WHEN TO USE IT</u> Use every 1<sup>1/</sup>2 to 3 hours as directed by your Use every 11/2 to 3 hou doctor, dentist or pharm

# - HOW LONG TO USE IT

You are advised not to use the mouthwash continuously for more than 7 days, unless your doctor, dentist or pharmacist tells you to.

# - IF YOU FORGET TO USE IT

If you forget to use your mouthwash, do not worry. Use it as soon as you remember and then carry on using it every 11/2 to 3 hours as before.

Do not use double the amount of mouthwash to make up for a forgotten dose.

- IF YOU USE TOO MUCH (OVERDOSE)
If you use too much Easiflam Mouthwash, or it
you accidentally swallow it, contact your
doctor, dentist or pharmacist for advice.

### WHILE YOU ARE USING **EASIFLAM MOUTHWASH**

- THINGS YOU MUST DO
Tell your doctor:

If you experience allergic reactions/ any of

- the unwanted side effects while taking the
- If you become pregnant while taking this
- If you do not feel better or if you feel worse after 7 days

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking Easiflam Mouthwash.

Use your mouthwash exactly as your doctor has told you.

- THINGS YOU MUST NOT DO
  Do not:
   swallow the mouthwash
   give Easiflam Mouthwash to anyone else
- even if they have the same condition as you use your mouthwash to treat any other complaints unless you are told by your doctor, dentist or pharmacist
- take more than the recommended dose unless your doctor, dentist or pharmacist tells you to

# THINGS TO BE CAREFUL OF

Easiflam Mouthwash has no or negligible influence on the ability to drive and use machines.

# SIDE EFFECTS

Like all medicines, Easiflam Mouthwash can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. Side effects vary from very rare to

he most common side effects are numbness nd a stinging feeling in the mouth.

are experiencing any of the following possible unwanted side effects while using the mouthwash:

- difficulty in speaking or breathing
   allergic reactions like rash

- · itchy rash, throat or tongue swelling, and
- Local adverse reactions: Dryness or thirst, tingling, warm feeling in mouth and alto sense of taste.
- Sense or taste.

  Systemic adverse reactions: nausea, retching, gastro-intestinal disorders, dizziness, headche and drowsiness, photodermatitis

Other unwanted side effects not listed may occur. Tell vour doctor immediately.

# STORAGE AND DISPOSAL OF **EASIFLAM MOUTHWASH**

- STORAGE Keep out of reach of children

Store below 30°C. Protect from light.

#### DISPOSAL
